



TDL French: 1'6" - 5 lite; 2'0" - 9, 10 lite; 2'4", 2'6", 2'8", 2'10, 3'0" - 9, 10, 15 lite

Faux French: 2'0"- 10 lite; 2'4", 2'6", 2'8", 3'0"- 15 lite

Etched^f: 2'0", 2'4", 2'6", 28", 3'0" (includes Wine, Pantry & Laundry)

Half-Lites⁹: 2'0", 2'4", 2'6", 2'8", 2'10", 3'0" (with lock rail)

12-lite with Panel⁹: 2'4", 2'6", 2'8", 2'10", 3'0" (with small 4-3/8" lock rail)

All French doors have tempered glass with a certified stamp as required by most building codes. Glass is compression-fit into natural hardwood mullions.

In addition, each tempered glass pane is individually wrapped with a plastic film to prevent scratches during finishing and delivery.

SPECIFICATION NOTES:

- a Dimension is to panel edge.
- b To maintain structural integrity, doors 1'10" or less have half the panel count shown in the door code (e.g. 1'8" 4TH = 2 panels).
- c Doors 1'4" and less have a 2-3/16" stile dimension width.
- d Size shown is for standard 6'8" French door. Bottom rail is 13-1/8" for a 7'0" door; 11-5/8" for a 7'6" and 8'0" door.
- e Certain door styles do not have lock rails.
- f Etched glass doors available in 6'8", 7'0" & 8'0" sizes. (Pantry Glass 8'0" is available with bottom panel).
- g Half-lite doors, including 12-lite, can be ordered with different glass styles.
- h 1-3/8" MDF bifolds require heavy duty hardware and are 7/8" smaller in height.
- i Heritage raised panel bifolds have a flat surface on reverse side (e.g. panels facing interior of closet).

Veneer faces may contain multiple flitches due to species and veneer machining limitations.

Dimensions are subject to engineering changes and product upgrades. Changes may occur at any time.

Paint-Grade MDF Profiles



Knotty Alder (KA):



Normally light brown with hues of red or peach; knots vary in size, shape and color. Its softer nature makes it receptive to a variety of stains and finishes.

Select Alder (SA):



Birch (B):

Strong, heavy wood. Color is usually medium brown heartwood with a light cream sapwood. Texture is fine and even; grain is typically straight.

Cherry (C):

Popular hardwood due to its warmth and rich personality. Color ranges from nearly white to light red to dark reddish brown; ages naturally. Texture is fine; grain can include delicate figuring, such as small spots, flecks and "beauty knots".

Hard Maple (MP):

Valued for its strength, beauty and resistance to wear. Texture is fine with a uniform grain and a fairly clear white color. Best when left natural with a clear seal coating.

Hickory (H):

The hardest, heaviest, and strongest American wood. Its natural color is white to tan to a reddish brown with fine brown lines. Tough and resilient, hickory stains and finishes well.

Khaya Mahogany (KM):

This African exotic is admired for its pinkish brown to deep reddish color. The texture is coarser than traditional American Mahogany with a straight grain that often includes a ribbon pattern of light and dark tones.



WOOD SPECIES AVAILABLE

Red Oak (0):

One of the most commonly available domestic hardwoods. Color ranges from pale reddish brown to light brown. Texture is medium fine with a uniform grain. Best when treated with a colored stain ranging from light to dark.



Tulip Poplar (P):

Moderately light, soft wood type. Very natural looking when clear sealed; takes on a distinguished look when stained in dark colors. Because its texture is fine and even, poplar also provides a smooth paintable surface.



Environmentally friendly, strong, and versatile material made from wood chips blended with synthetic resins. Paint grade surface is flat, smooth and uniform; provides an easy-topaint surface with a consistent, finished look.

This applies to both flat panel doors and bifolds.
